Product Description:

DAP® DRAFT ATTACK® Removable Weatherstrip Sealant is formulated for use as a seasonal weatherstripping product. It provides a watertight, weatherproof and fast drying seal against air and moisture, keeping homes warmer in winter, cooler in summer, while also reducing energy bills. Use it to seal drafty windows, seasonally used doors, around air conditioners, vents or fans. Then peel away when no longer needed. Interior and exterior use.

Surface Preparation & Application:

- 1. Remove any loose or foreign material.
- 2. Clean & dry surface. The surfaces must be free of creosote, oil, grease, wax, silicone, silicone-based product, asphalt or bitumen-based product, and any material soluble in solvents.
- 3. Trim nozzle to desired bead size. Cut the nozzle at a right angle (90°) slightly narrower than the width of the gap.
- **4.** Puncture inner foil seal.
- 5. Load cartridge into caulking gun.
- **6.** Fill gaps with sealant.
- **7.** Do not shape or tool the bead.

DO NOT SEAL FIRE EXITS. ALLOW FRESH AIR ENTRY DURING APPLICATION AND DRYING.

FOR BEST RESULTS

- Apply in temperatures above 5°C.
- Store away from extreme heat or cold, below 27°C.
- Not for continuous underwater use.
- Do not use on freshly painted surfaces. Product may peel or damage wallpaper, fresh paint or loose uncured paint.
- Do not use on insulating panels or plastic materials which can be damaged by solvents
- New metal and solvent resistant oily surfaces must be washed with acetone and dried.
- For unusual substrates, perform a test for adhesion prior to use.
- For gaps wider than 6mm, backer rod should be used.
- The sealant should come into contact with each of the surfaces on a width of at least 3mm.
- If applied indoors, the area must be ventilated during application and drying time.
- Product left in place for more than 1 year may be difficult to remove.

Clean-Up & Storage:

While product is still wet use a solvent-moistened cloth. After the product has dried, excess material may be easily peeled away. Do not use solvent to clean hands. Reseal opened cartridge for future use. Store in a cool dry place, below 27°C, away from extreme cold or heat.
